Keeping Safe



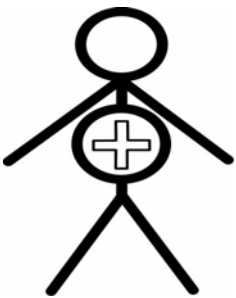
The group talked about how Keep Safe Cards have now been launched in Hinckley.

Better Health

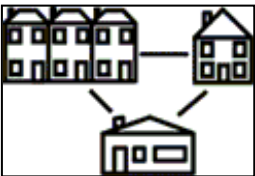


The group were asked to think about how we can use the Accident and Emergency Grab Sheet for the walk in centres, minor injury units, community hospitals and the ambulance service.

The group talked about the 'Make My Stay project'. This means when someone with a learning disability goes into hospital the computer puts a red tick next to their name.

There is also going to be a Big Health Day on 21st June 2010 at the Leicester Tigers Ground. There are 100 places and each locality have 10 places each.

The group has been working on updating the Housing Questionnaire. This is a questionnaire that people are asked to fill in when they decide that they want to change where they live. It can be used as part of a person's annual review or assessment. The questionnaire that was being used has gone to lots of different people such as carers and Social Care Workers for their questions and comments on how we can make it better. These comments will be used to make a new Housing Questionnaire that we can start using soon.

Family Carer's

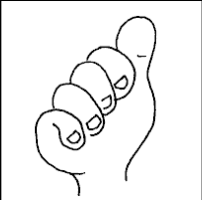




The group have been working on their new action plan. Out of the action plan the group have agreed to put together a business card that can be handed out at events.
