

Notes of the last meeting

Anita is going to e-mail Janie to ask if Julian Robertson can attend a Partnership Board meeting

Alix is going to resend an e-mail to Darren about how a Police Officer reacted to her incident on the bus so he can follow it up.

Actions:

- Anita to still and try and get the rap video from Annie or Jess
- Gurjit is going to e-mail Sarjit who manages the CERT team, to ask her to speak with the CERT workers to find out who has Trading Standards packs and to ask the locality groups what they want and need.
- Janie is going to speak to the bus companies to ask them to attend a Partnership Board meeting as there are too many bus drivers and bus companies to attend all of the locality groups.

Janie said that she had come to the meeting today to speak about the event that the Partnership Board was putting on in June 2017.

Janie said that it was a celebration event helping to raise awareness around disability and that it was going to happen at the Police Head Quarters on Saturday 24th June 2017, 11 – 5 pm.

There are going to be lots of different zones including things on fire safety, hate, community safety, keep safe and a children's fun zone.

Gurjit said that the IMPACT Team, that work with Leicestershire Youth Offending Service have lots of resources that could be used at this event and that perhaps Janie could speak to Kam Chauhan, the manager of the IMPACT team about using them.

Actions:

 Janie is going to speak to Kam Chauhan about using the IMPACT Team resources at the event Gurjit is going to speak to the Fire Service to see if they can bring a Fire Engine to the event.



Launch of Better Journey Cards

Darren said that the Better Journey Cards had been launched and that there were messages for bus drivers on them.

The cards aren't in easy read.

Darren said that 1500 cards had been sent to each District Council and that they should be sending them out to the locality groups.

It was agreed that the cards were going to be taken to the Partnership Board and that the localities should make sure that they all get some.

Mate Crime was talked about and Fiona felt that the Police didn't have enough knowledge about this. Darren said he could talk to the Police about this.

Action:

 Darren is going to e-mail Janie about taking some of the Better Journey Cards to the Partnership Board.



Keep Safe Message for Christmas 2016

Rik said that there was going to be a press release about the Keep Safe message for Christmas 2016. Rik said that it reminded the festive shoppers of where the keep safe places were and that there was lots of publicity about it.

Rik didn't know exactly when the press release was going to be sent out but that he had a copy of it which could be sent out to this group.

Action:

 Rebecca to send out the Keep Safe Message for Christmas 2016 press release to the group



Hate Campaign Week – 8th – 15th October 2016 feedback

During the Hate Campaign week, Rik said that there were television and radio interviews, newspaper articles, market stalls and interfaith workshops that all help raise awareness of hate.

Rik also said that if anyone wanted any more information about the Hate Campaign week then they could speak to Anita about it.



How often should the meetings happen

Gurjit said that it had been decided that these meetings should happen twice a year but that we could have extra meetings in between if we needed to.

Becs is going to arrange the next meeting for April and cancel the one already booked in for June.

We do need to make sure that we have somebody from each locality group attend this meeting as not all of the information from this meeting is being feedback to the locality groups.

It is up to the Chair of the locality groups to invite the Police or the Council to their meetings and Gurjit said that her Community Safety team will make sure that they attend more locality meetings. It was agreed that attendance at locality groups would be added to the Hate and Prevent meeting agenda.

Gurjit said that she has already written to all of the districts asking them to attend the locality meetings but that she would do this again.

Actions:

 Rebecca is going to arrange the next Keep Safe Sub Group Meeting for April

- Darren and Anita are going to put attendance at locality groups on the Hate and Prevent meeting agenda.
- Darren is going to send Gurjit the names of all the NPA Commanders so that she can ask them to talk to their local officers and ask them to attend their locality group meetings. Gurjit is also going to send this e-mail on to Janie so she can send it to the CERT Chairs and Workers.
