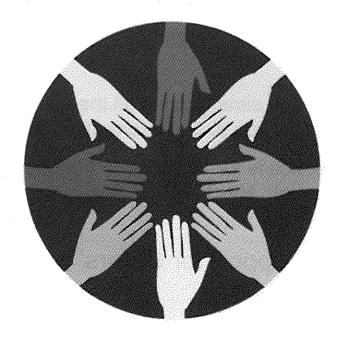

'Support for Carers' is a service delivered by the community-based organisation Voluntary Action South Leicestershire with funding from Leicestershire County Council.

The service aims to bring all the support services for carers under one roof to make it easier for you to find information, advice and support.

The Carers' Telephone Befriending Scheme has been successfully supporting carers for four years.

We are now able to offer the service to carers countywide.

The befrienders are all trained volunteers who really understand the issues which surround being a carer.

The calls, which are all confidential, can be light-hearted serious or just an opportunity to get it all off your chest!

It is not a commitment to be at home at the same time every week. If you are there that's fine; if you are out, the befriender will just try you the following week.

Carer's Support Grant



Carer's Support Grant is a one-off grant intended to supplement the support for carers of adults (aged 18 years and over) by enabling the carer to take 'real time off' from caring, to reduce the impact of caring on health and well-being and support the carer to continue in their caring role

How can the money be used?

- Short breaks
- Sitting/respite service
- Physical work around the home e.g. gardening/decorating/cleaning
- Gym membership, driving lessons
