Children and Families Act



 In April 2014 there was a new law this is called the Children and Families Act

The Children and Families Act says that People working together with individuals and families, including social care and health focus on a person centred approach





Children and Families Act 2014



 Children and young people should have more choice and control over their own life (personalisation)



 We need to Support children and young people to plan and prepare for adulthood



Preparing for Adulthood







- There are 4 main areas in preparing for adulthood

- 2. Finding somewhere to live
- 3. Being involved in your local community
- 4. Staying healthy and safe

Children and young people
 with special educational needs
 used to have a statement of
 special educational needs

- This has now changed into an Education, Health and Care Plan.
- In Leicestershire the first step is a SEND support plan.





Education, Health and Care Plans





- Education, Health and Care Plans must include:
- Interests of the child/young person
- Aspirations (the things they would like to do in the future)
- Views from parents and carers
- We use One page profiles to get this information





Education, Health and Care Plans






 What are the outcomes across Education, Health and Social Care
