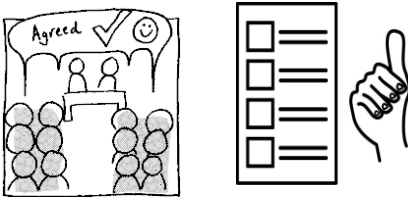

The next meeting will be on Thursday 7 March 2018 at County Hall 10:00 – 12:00.



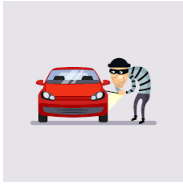
**4. Victim First – Sian Wilson**

Sian introduced herself and thanked everyone for inviting her along to the group.

We are a team who support people to cope and recover from being a victim of crime and to give you all the information and advice you need. We have a team of professional case workers who help to make sure victims are supported throughout this process.

A short discussion took place about the type of support people might need help with:

- Breaking in and burglary
- Stealing
- Abuse



- Car theft
- Cash machine fraud
- Accidents
- Bullying which is now known as HATE crime. Sian said that this is taken very seriously.
- Emotional abuse – support is available if you feel frightened and unable to go out.

Sian reminded everyone about the importance of reporting all crime to the Police, no matter how small. If necessary they will pass the necessary information to us so that we can make contact with you to offer any support you might need. Sian also confirmed that if you were feeling sad, angry or a bit emotional, or lonely, we can come out to your home to speak to you face to face.

Marie was asked to include the leaflet giving all the numbers and email address when she sends out the minutes.

Sian reported that personal alarms and bag/purse alarms are available if anyone wanted them.

Sian confirmed that if there were any safeguarding issues they would then have to report them to the Police.

### Activities in the Community:

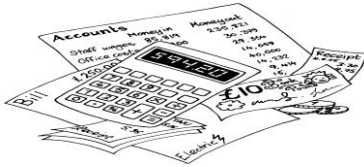
- Tracey gave out the following information about what is happening within the community, some daily, weekly and monthly:
